

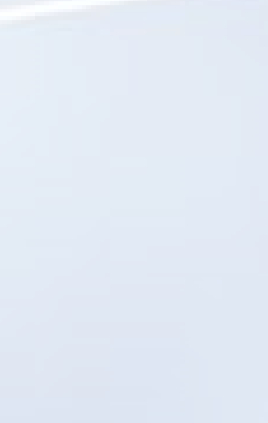

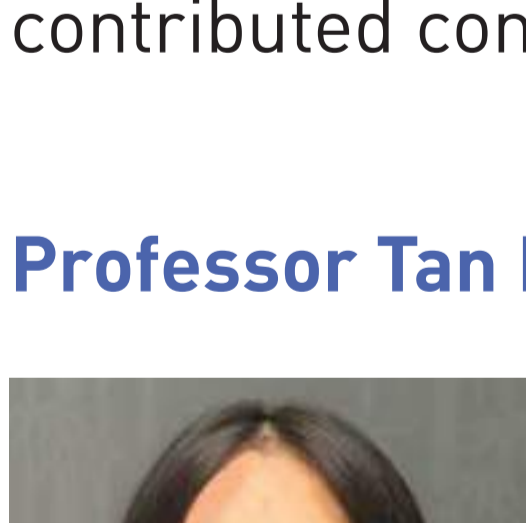
### Dr Eric Lee Kim Hor



**Dr Eric Lee Kim Hor** is a Consultant Paediatrician in Pantai Hospital Kuala Lumpur. He obtained his MD from University Kebangsaan Malaysia in 1990 and completed his MRCP (UK) from Royal College of Physicians, London in 1995. He worked with the respiratory unit in UK under the Royal College of Physicians in London while undergoing the Overseas Doctors Training Scheme from 1994 till 1995. Once back in Malaysia, he served in the paediatric department of Hospital Kuala Lumpur before moving to private practice.

**Dr Eric** is an advocate of childhood immunisation and has given several talks to both medical professionals and parents on the benefits of vaccination. He has also contributed content to some publications on paediatric and child health.

### Professor Tan Maw Pin



**Professor Tan Maw Pin** is attached to the Division of Geriatric Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya. She obtained her Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery from the University of Nottingham in 1998 and completed her MRCP (UK) in 2001. Professor Tan received a Doctorate of Medicine with Commendation from Newcastle University in 2009 and was Consultant Geriatrician with a Specialist Interest in Falls and Syncope, at Newcastle upon Tyne NHS Foundation Trust (2009-2011) before returning to Malaysia. She is a Fellow to the College of Physicians, Academy of Medicine Malaysia (Geriatrics) and the Royal College of Physicians, London.

**Professor Tan** is the Honorary Secretary of the Malaysian Society of Geriatric Medicine. She is actively involved in research and is the Lead for Ageing and Regenerative Medicine Research Thrust, Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya and Research Coordinator, Department of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya. She has published more than a hundred research papers over the past 5 years. Professor Tan is the Academic Editor to PLOS ONE and Associate Editor of Frontiers of Medicine.

### Dr Anza binti Elias



**Dr Anza** is an Occupational Health Physician at Twin Towers Medical Centre. She obtained her Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery from University of Tasmania, Australia in 1996. She completed her Master of Community Medicine (Occupational Health) from University Kebangsaan Malaysia in 2007 and Membership of Faculty of Occupational Medicine, Royal College of Physician, Ireland in 2014.
